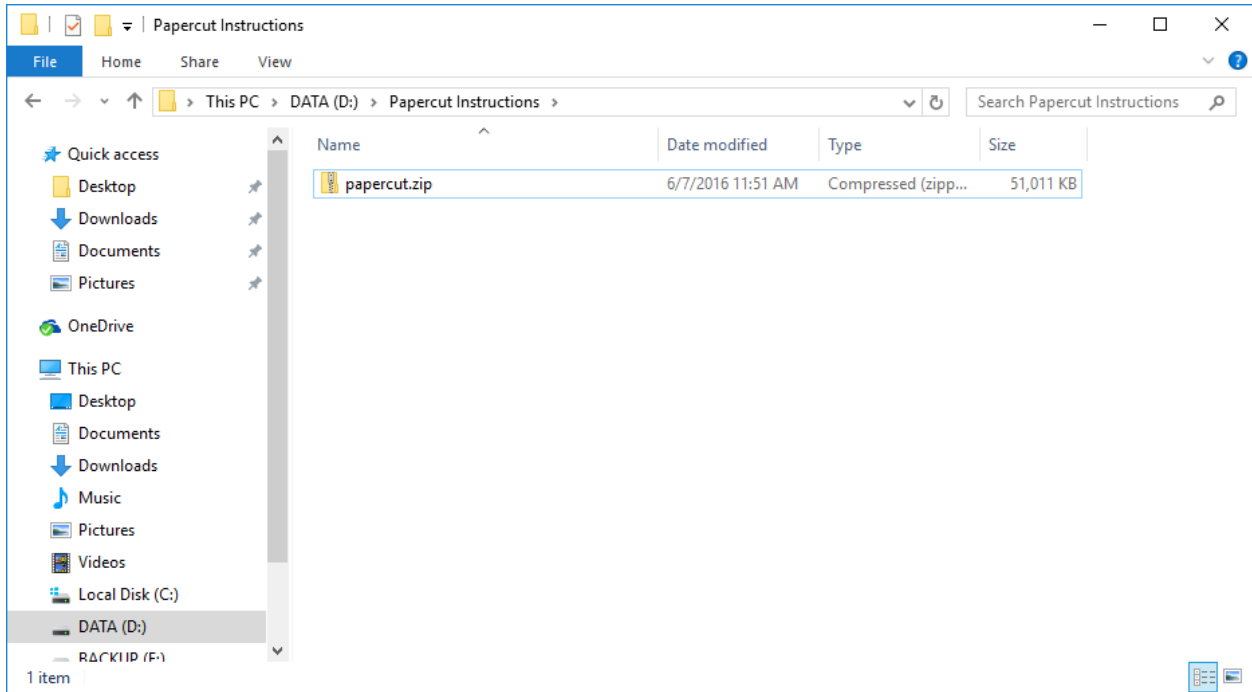
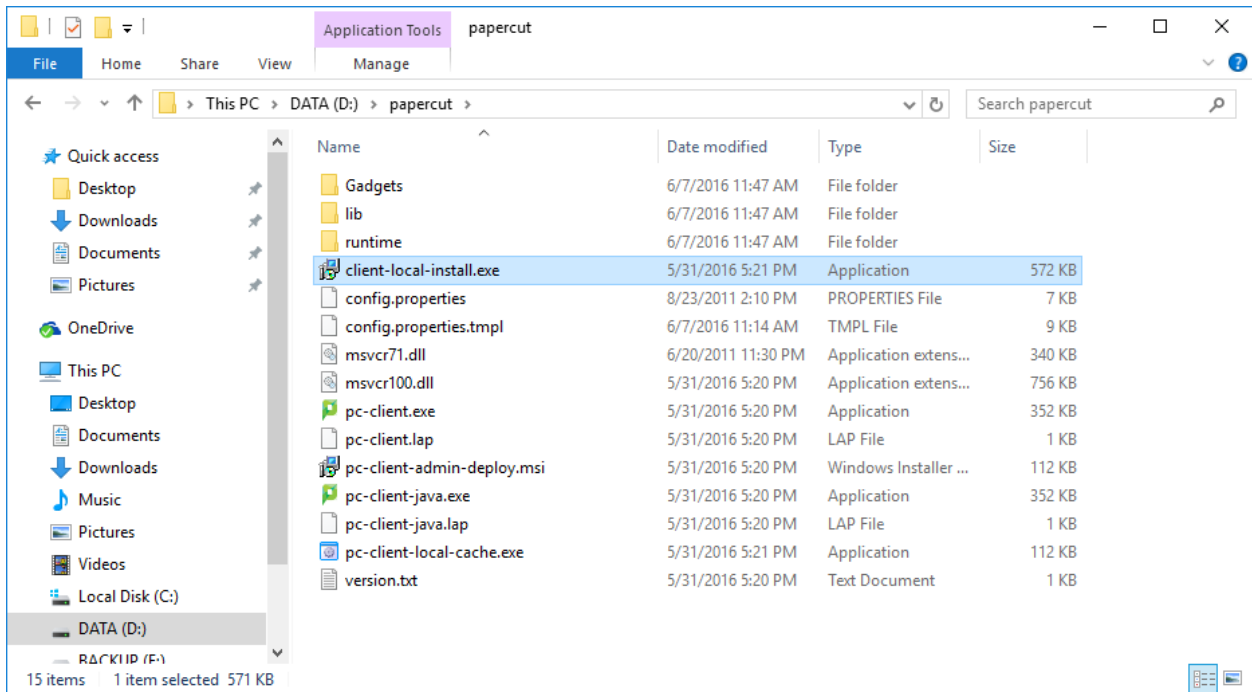


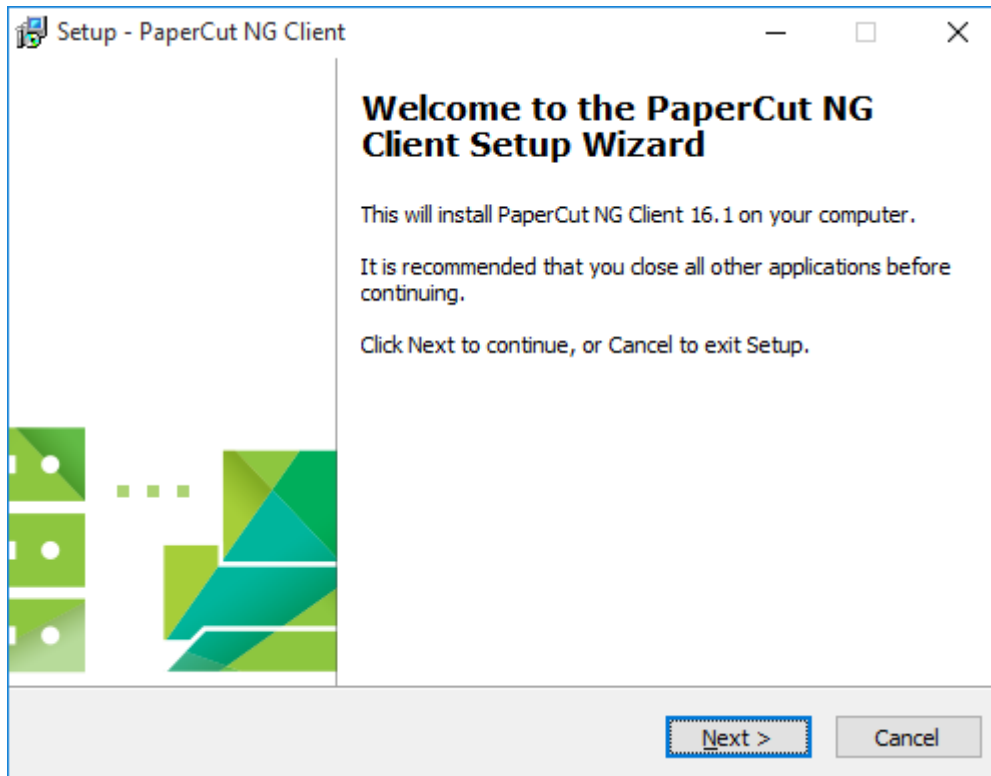
After downloading the file Right-Click on the papercut.zip file and choose “Extract All..” Choose a location to extract the files to.



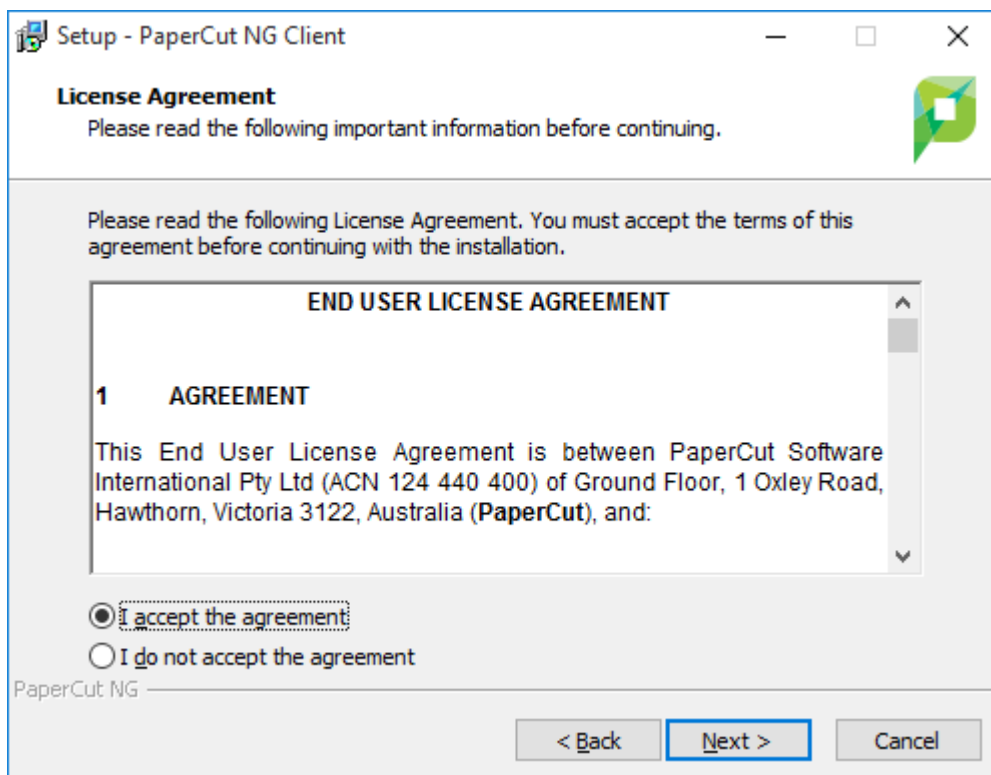
After the files are extracted go to the location you extracted them to and double-click on the “client-local-install.exe” file.



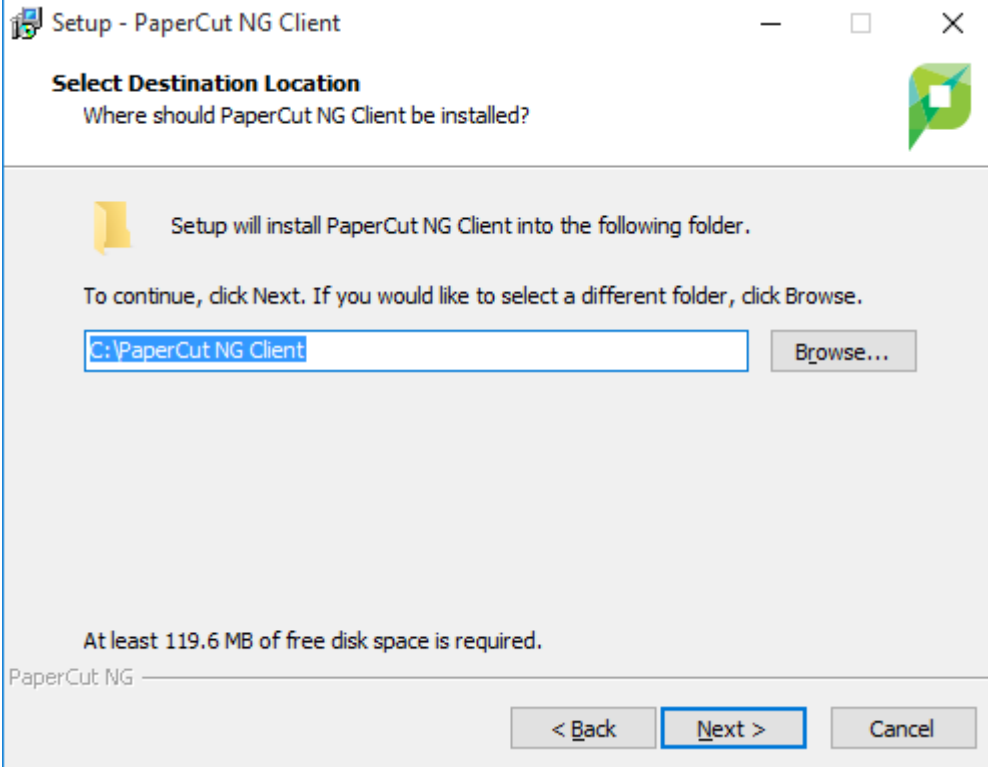
This will start the install process. Click next to continue.



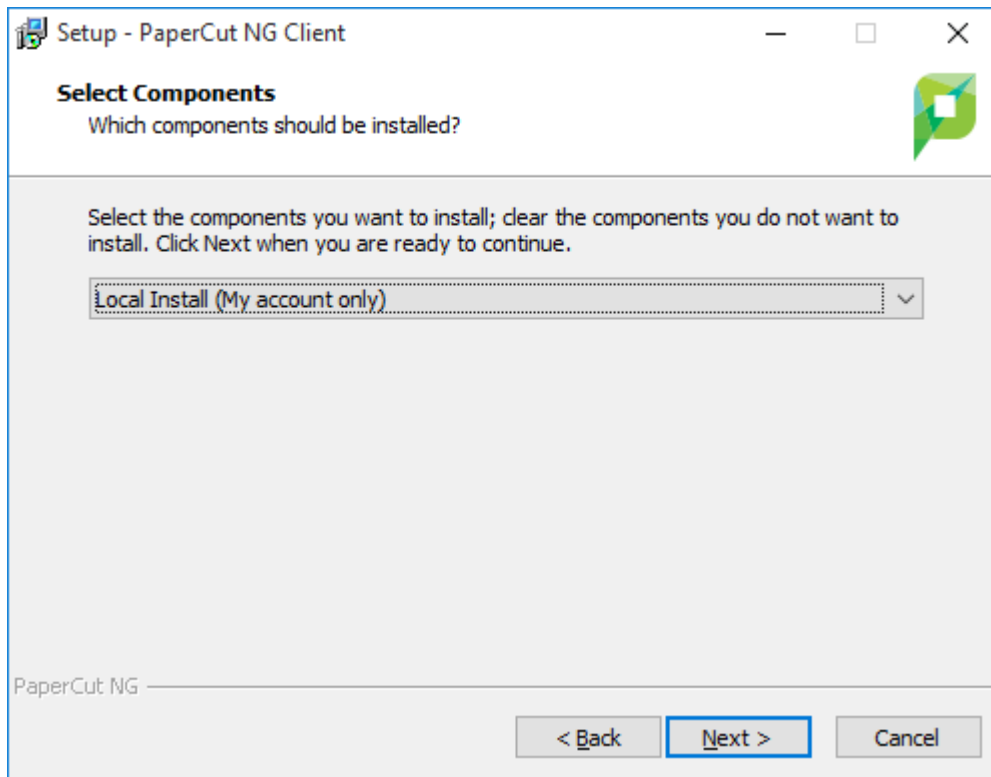
Select the "I accept the agreement" for the license and click NEXT.



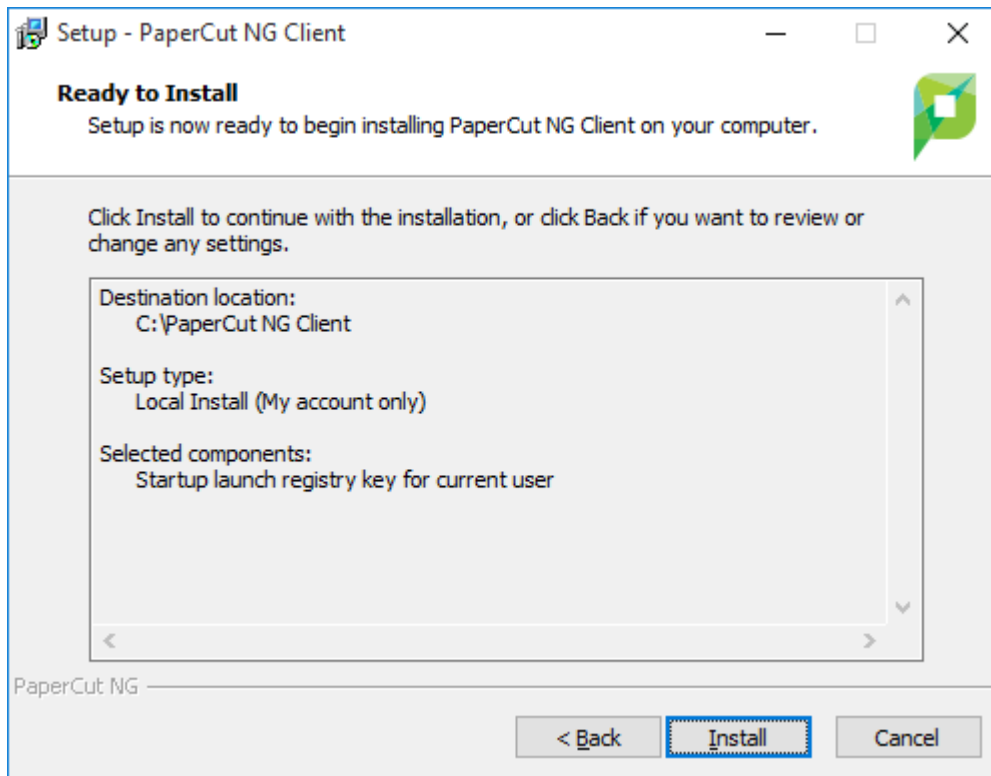
Tell the installer where you want to install papercut or accept the default location.



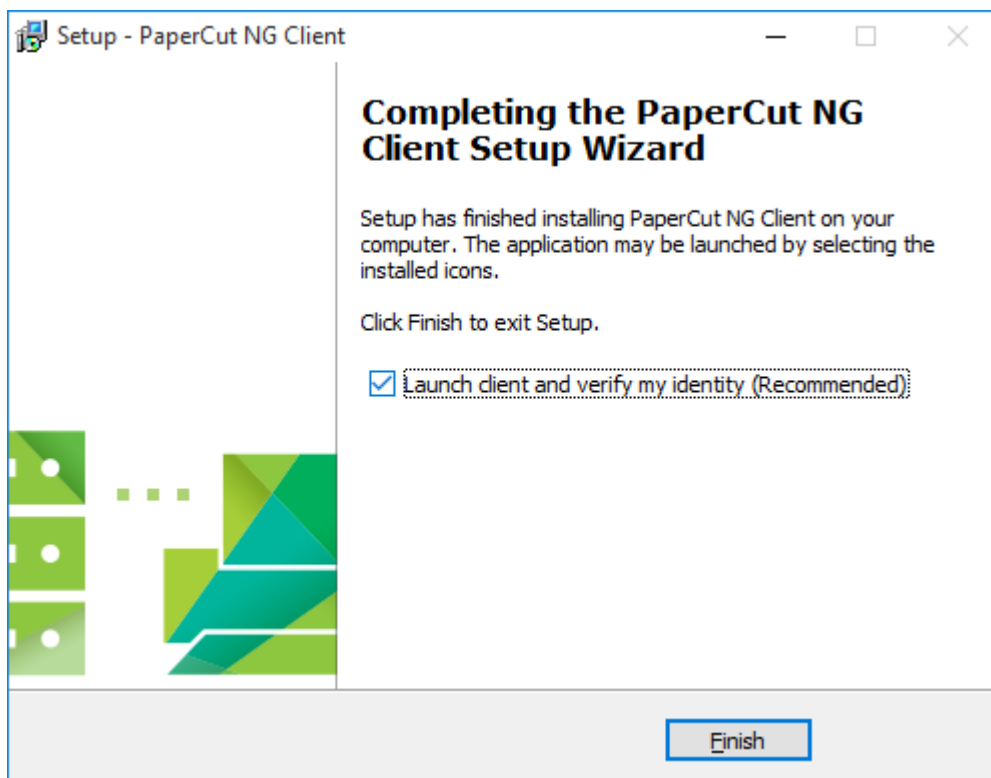
Choose if you want to install just for your current account or for anyone who uses the computer. Click Next.




Click Install to continue the install.
